

1) With what average can I compete at the competition?

Anyone with any time result can participate at the competition. If you like the Rubik's Cube and would like to meet others who like it as well, you should come. :)

2) How can I register for the competition?

You can find a detailed description on the [Registration / Regisztráció](#) page.

3) I didn't get a confirmation e-mail about my registration. What should I do now?

You will get a conformation e-mail when we get your registration and when we accept your registration. The first one is send automatically and you get it immediately, but the second one is not as fast, there are cases when you have to wait even a few days. (Because accepting registrations is not automatic, organizers have to do it individually.) Please be patient and wait, we will inform you as soon as we can.

4) I registered but cannot see my name on the list on registered competitors. What should I do?

Accepting registrations is not automatic, one of the organizers have to approve every registration (after receiving the registration fee). That can take for a few days (sometimes more then a week), please wait patiently!

5) I don't know my WCA ID. How can I find it?

If you have competed before, you can write in your name on the [WCA website](#) in the search box and you can find it. (It' a 10 character long text.)

If you have not competed before you don't have a WCA ID, so there is no need to get one for the registration. You will get a WCA ID automatically, after the competition results have been posted.

6) I want to edit my registration. How can I do that?

If you want to change something on your registration and it's not affecting the number of the days for you have registered, just write an e-mail to the hungarianopen.info@gmail.com e-mail address with the changes. (Changing your events is only possible until the deadline of the registration.)

7) What should I do if I registered for 1 day, but I want to compete on more days?

In this case you should write an e-mail to the hungarianopen.info@gmail.com e-mail address with the event(s) which needs to be added, and send us the extra fee the same way as you paid your registration. (You have to provide all the info that you did provide for the first payment. Changing your events is only possible until the deadline of the registration.)

8) What should I do if I'm registered for more days but I can be there just for 1 day?

In this case you should write an e-mail to the hungarianopen.info@gmail.com e-mail address with the event(s) which needs to be removed. Please note, that refunding payments is not possible.

9) If I registered online does it mean that I don't have to register at the venue?

No, the online registration and the on-site registration are required as well. The on-site registration means that:

- You sign the attendance list
- If you are under 18 years old we ask for one your parent's phone number.
- If it's your first competition we have to check an ID card with a picture to check your identity, your correct Name, Birthdate.
- If you have any debit from former competitions you have to pay it there.

10) When should I arrive to the competition?

You have to arrive at least 20-30 minutes before your first event, because registration can take for a few minutes. And if it's your first competition or you are not confident with the regulations please be at the venue at the competition tutorial event on your first competition day, because we will make a small demonstration on how the competition runs and summarize the regulations. (It doesn't exempt you from reading the [WCA Regulations](#).)

11) If I'm not competing on Friday/Saturday, then I don't need to be there on Friday/Saturday, do I?

If you are not competing on Friday/Saturday of course you don't have to be there, it's enough to come on Sunday.

12) If I'm competing on Sunday only, but I would like to be there on Friday/Saturday as well, than do I need to pay the registration fee for 2 days?

In this case you don't need to pay the registration fee for all days, just of 1 day, but you have to pay the spectator fee at the venue for the other day(s).

13) If I will compete on Sunday only, can I judge or scramble on the other days?

No, because only competitors are allowed to judge and scramble, and on the other days you will not be a competitor.

14) What should I bring with me to the competition?

If it's your first competition you will need to bring some kind of card/paper with photo for identification (ID Card, Student Card, Passport and your puzzles. (On the competition everybody uses their own puzzles.)

15) I've read in the WCA Regulations that if someone is not competing exactly, they have to help in judging/scrambling. Is it true?

Yes. Every event is divided into groups, so you will compete in one and need to help in the other(s).

16) How can I know in which group I'm assigned to compete in?

We will send you the grouping on the week before the competition.

17) Is it possible to use one of my friends puzzle for competing?

If you have a request like this, please write an e-mail to hungarianopen.info@gmail.com e-mail address before the registration deadline and we will make the grouping according to that. (If it's possible, not holding back the process of the competition and doesn't cause any problem from organization view.)

18) When should I pay the registration fee?

The registration fee should be paid online. You can find a detailed description on the [Registration / Regisztráció](#) site.

19) How many spectators can come with a competitor?

This number is not limited for Saturday, but on Sunday only 1 guest per competitor can stay at the venue. You can find more information at the question number 30).

20) How is the competition running exactly?

If you are a newcomer, you can find a tutorial [here](#).

21) Will be there any unofficial events at the competition?

The Mosaic Building event will be held at Hungarian Open 2018.

22) Who will be honored at the competition?

The international podium of every event will get a certificate and a medal.

23) Should I wait for the Winning Ceremony?

No, if you finished with your events and you will not be awarded you can go home of course.

24) Will there be a recommended accommodation for the competition?

No, the reservation of accommodation will be made individually. You can find a suitable accommodation on the [booking.com](#) website.

25) The 200 competitors limit is valid for the events separately?

No, this number is valid for the total number of the registered competitors.

For example: If there are 180 registered competitors for the competition, but for the 2x2x2 event there are 150 registered competitor only, we cannot accept more registration for the 2x2x2 event either.

26) How long does it take to accept my registration?

The international bank transfer could take 4-5 business days to arrive. We are getting a new list about the arrived payments on every week once so we can accept new registrations on that days only.

28) Where will I get my ticket? Should I take it over at the RubikShop's receiving place?

Of course you shouldn't. You will get your ticket at the competition.

29) My parents/friends want to come to the competition as guests. Where can they buy a ticket?

You cannot buy it pre-emption, just at the venue.

30) Is it true, that in Sunday morning I can bring only 1 guest to the venue? What rules are concerned about this?

- On Sunday only one guest per competitor can stay at the venue.
- Competitors need to write the name of this 1 guest in the "Comment" box during WCA registration.
- The guest ticket for Sunday costs: 1.000 Ft
- Competitors can modify the name of their guest for Sunday morning until the 13rd of September, 2019 - 14:00 on the hungarianopen.info@gmail.com e-mail address.
- If a competitor writes more names in the "Comment" box, we will use take only the first name valid.
- There is no need to give the names of those guests who will come on Friday/Saturday only!

This rule is needed to ensure the comfort to the competitors which they need. Last years there were so many guests in the room that there were competitors who could not sit down.

31) If I would not compete on Sunday, but I proceed to the next round of 4x4x4 and/or 3x3x3 One-handed, how can I participate at the competition if I did not buy a ticket in advance?

If your only event on Sunday is 4x4x4 and/or 3x3x3 One-Handed than you can come to the competition on Sunday for free.
